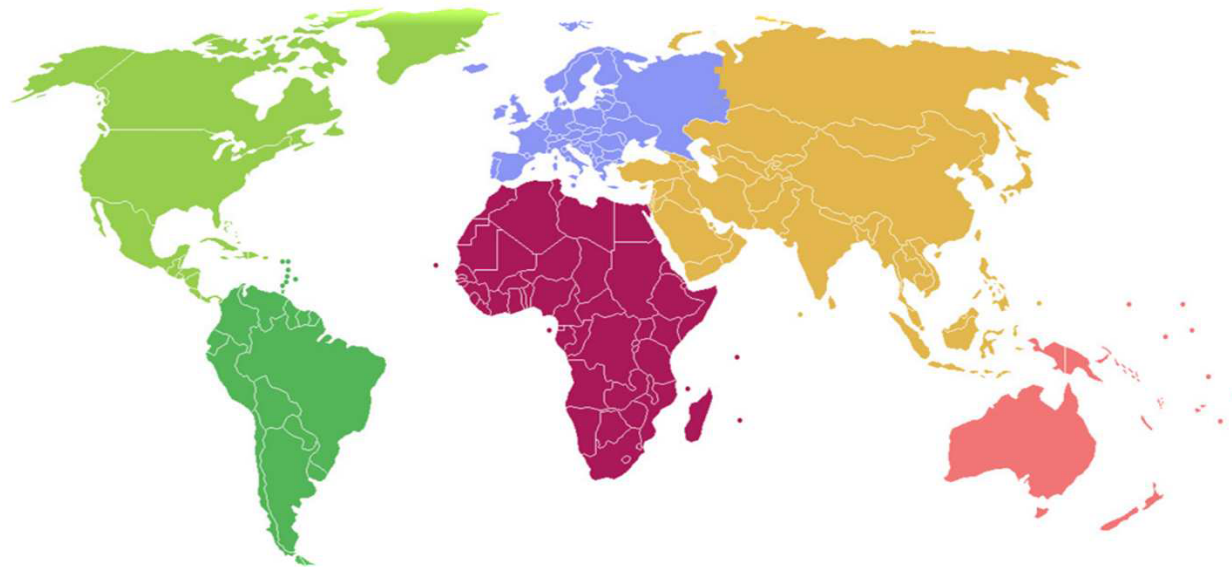

- Integrated into SpringerLink

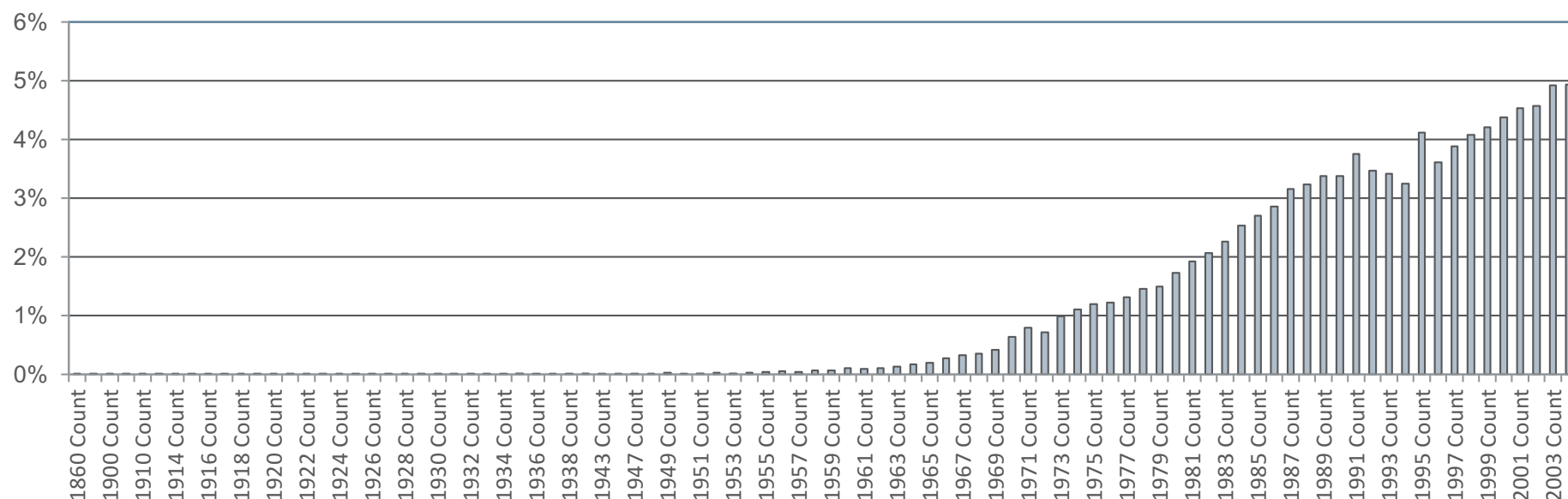


Springer Book Archives – Age of the content
